

- The <u>wisdom</u> tradition of the faith often spoke of **the Way**. *God watches over the way of the righteous*. *Psalm 1:6*
- The <u>prophetic</u> tradition of the faith also refers to faith as *a Way*. *Prepare the way of our God, make straight in the desert a highway for our God* ... *Isaiah 40*
- Jesus refers to himself and his commitment to a cruciform *Way* of life as, *"I am the way." John 14:6*
- Paul advising the early church in Corinth being torn as under with division counsels that in the way of love, he would show them "a more excellent way." I Corinthians 12:31
